Please take note that anyone applying must meet the minimum requirements under New York State Civil Services as described below.

GENERAL OVERVIEW OF POSITION:

Under the general supervision of higher-level employee, the incumbent of this class is responsible for performing a wide variety of skilled mechanical repair, diagnostic, and maintenance work on all types of automotive equipment, including heavy equipment vehicles e.g. tractor trailers, front end loaders, bulldozers, steam rollers, sweepers, etc. The Senior Automotive Mechanic is responsible for carrying out a preventive maintenance program on municipal vehicles and for the require maintenance and mechanical repairs on disabled equipment in the field. Incumbents may be required to operate varied types of automotive equipment. Supervision may be exercised over subordinate employees. Does related work as required.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES:

Thorough knowledge of the tools, techniques and terminology associated with the automotive and heavy equipment mechanics trade; thorough knowledge of the maintenance of motor equipment of all types; good knowledge of the operation and use of automotive and other motor driven equipment; good knowledge of the accident and safety precautions of the trade, skill in operating front-end repair equipment and shop-testing equipment; demonstrated ability to perform difficult repairs on all types of automobile and heavy equipment vehicles, ability to readily and accurately diagnose mechanical difficulties; ability to read and interpret technical repair manuals, circuit diagrams and blueprints, ability to read and understand technical drawings, shop prints, mechanical curve charts, etc.; ability to work from oral or written instructions and without instructions from own diagnosis; ability to lay out, organize and plan the work of others,; ability to read, write, speak, understand and communicate in English sufficiently to perform the essential duties of the position; good interpersonal skills; initiative; resourcefulness; good judgment; physical strength and agility; physical condition commensurate with the duties of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE:

Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and five (5) of experience where the primary function of the position was maintenance and repair work on automotive and/or heavy motor equipment.

SUBSTITUTION:

An Associate's Degree* in Auto Mechanics, Automotive Technology or a related field or possession of a certificate from a post-secondary vocational school* in Auto Mechanics, Automotive Technology or a related field may be substituted for two (2) years of work experience described above.



SPECIAL REQUIREMENT:

At time of appointment, possession of a valid license, appropriate for the vehicle to be operated and issued by the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles. The appointing authority is responsible for verifying and ensuring that the candidate meets these conditions at time of appointment and throughout the course of employment.

<u>*SPECIAL NOTE:</u> Education beyond the secondary level must be from an institution recognized or accredited by the Board of Regents of the New York State Department of Education as a post-secondary, degree-granting institution.



Senior Automotive Mechanic duties and equipment responsibilities

Removes and repairs gasoline or diesel (internal) combustion engines, including fitting or crankshafts, pistons, pins and bearings.

Removes and adjusts carburetors, distributors.

Removes and overhauls transmissions, including automatic transmissions and differentials.

Maintains and repairs fuel, cooling, and exhaust systems.

Inspects, maintains, and repairs electrical systems, chassis units, and accessories.

Review and recommend replacement vehicles, trucks and all equipment.

Operates valve-grinder, drill press, lathe, welding and burning equipment, and other associated tools.

Repairs or assists in the repairs of snow plows, road rollers, and various miscellaneous mowers, pumps, etc.

Performs inspections of automotive equipment as part of a preventative maintenance program.

Operate automotive equipment including trucks, snow plowing, garbage trucks, rollers, graders, front end loaders, back hoes, etc., as required.

Change oil and filters on about 20 pieces of equipment change brakes.

Repair and or replace air cans on larger trucks

Replace seal bearings on larger trucks

Replace fuel pumps.

Grease vehicles.

Small engine repairs (weed whackers, snow blowers, leaf blowers etc.)

Change tires on all vehicles.

Repair or replace hydraulic pumps and hoses

Trouble shoot electrical problems on vehicles and repair.



Have the ability to fabricate parts if necessary.

General experience preferred:

- Welding
- Plasma Cutting
- Basic carpentry skills
- Basic masonry skills
- Basic electrical work skills

In addition, may perform additional duties as necessary, including, but not limited to:

- Cut grass
- Use sickle bar tractor
- Paint stop bars and parking lots
- Cut trees
- Weed whack
- Prep ballfield
- Be able to operate back hoe and loader, garbage truck, snow plowing and other heavy equipment
- Change traffic lights and street light
- Repair pool pumps and equipment
