RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR SANITATION AND REFUSE PICKUP

Garbage pails should be no larger than 32 gallons or over 60 pounds – as per Village Code.

Pickup should not go out before **5:00 P.M.** the night before scheduled pickup day...Empty receptacles should be removed from curb area within 24 hours after collection.

No recycling can be mixed with household garbage – this will be strictly enforced.

Paper Recycling: Newspapers and magazines should be tied or placed in a paper bag. Boxes should be broken down and tied.

WOODCHIPPER: Branches for woodchipper should be no smaller than one inch in diameter and at least 5' long. Anything smaller must be tied. Branches should be put out butt end to curb.

GRASSCYCLE: Do not blow grass clippings into the street !!! The Village can no longer pick up grass clippings. Grass clippings that are mixed with leaves or garbage will be left at curbside.

LEAF PICKUP: Do not place leaves in the roadway or sidewalks, it creates drainage problems and is a hazard subject to fine – Village Code 163-2 B & C. Keep leaves out of roadway and off the sidewalks, also keep rocks, sticks and branches out of the leaf piles.

SNOW: Snow and ice should be removed from sidewalks within 12 hours as per village code and thereafter shall be free of any accumulation of snow and ice. Do not shovel snow into the street!

Remove basketball hoops from the streets for the winter season. They could be damaged by the snow plow.

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS: If you are having work done on your home or property the contractor is responsible for removal of all debris

TV AND COMPUTER SCREENS: Computer and television screens will be picked up up on <u>Fridays in both Upper and Lower Village</u> the weeks that bulk pickup is picked up.
