

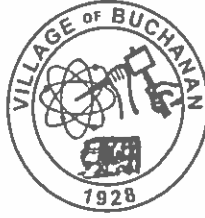

DICKEY BROOK - How many times have you crossed over Dickey Brook? You probably don't know. Well Dickey Brook forms a southern natural boundary between Peekskill and a northern boundary of Buchanan. As to the origin of its name, "Dickey" was connected to Richard Abramson, a large land owner and the brook flowed through his property.

Dickey Brook originates at the north end of Lafayette Avenue in Peekskill, enters Lounsbury Pond, exits south end of the pond, which goes under Washington Street, Route 9 under Metro North and Route 9A, alongside of the former Standard Coated products to Lent's Cove and to the Hudson River.

Many years ago, before Anti-Pollution Laws and chemical discharges in the Hudson River, Standard Coated dumped what they called "DOB" in the brook and it ran into the Hudson. At times the brook would be red, blue or the color of the paint that was being used that day.
