WHEREAS, pursuant to section 3-301(2)(a) of the Village Law of the State of New York, the board of trustees of any village by resolution subject to permissive referendum may abolish the office of Village Justice to take effect upon the expiration of the current term of such office, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has investigated and has performed a careful cost analysis of the efficiency and economics of abolishing said office and the value of the town justices assuming the functions heretofore performed by the Village Justice; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Board to conduct a Public Hearing on the proposed Resolution abolishing said office of Village Justice;

NOW BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Village Board will conduct a Public Hearing at the Village Municipal Building on January 6, 2014 at 7:30 p.m. for the purpose of taking public comment on, and giving due consideration to, the proposed Resolution abolishing the office of Village Justice; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Village Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to publish notice of said Public Hearing in the official newspaper.
