**WHEREAS**, New York State Technology Law Section 208 establishes procedures to be followed to notify affected individuals in the event of a breach of a computer security system and requires municipalities to adopt a notification policy or local law consistent with these procedures; and

**WHEREAS**, NYS has recently enacted the Stop Hacks and Improve Electronic Data Security Act ("SHIELD Act") which amends New York General Business Law 899-aa and adds Section 899-bb to significantly expand consumer privacy protections and the consequences of a data breach for businesses; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board of Trustees recognizes the importance of having such a policy and has reviewed the proposed Cyber Breach Notification Policy and has recommended approval.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the annexed Village of Buchanan Cyber Breach Notification Policy is hereby approved and adopted as the Village's official policy; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that the Village Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to take such actions as may be necessary to implement the Policy; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
